



Project Update

Welcome to Dear Neighbour, the newsletter that keeps everyone up to date with progress on the Abbey View Primary Academy project.

The overall proposal for Buckinghamshire County Council is to deliver a two form of entry (2FE) primary school with nursery, to be built in two phases.

The first phase, due to start on site in August 2018, will see Morgan Sindall's project team deliver a new 1FE school and nursery, future-proofed to expand to 2FE at a later date. The new school will meet 'Secure by Design' standards as appropriate.

The development is part of a Section 106 Planning Agreement with Taylor Wimpey and Wycombe District Council. The school is within the new housing development, Pine Trees, currently under construction at the former RAF/USAF Daws Hill site.

In order to accommodate future expansion of the local residential developments, the new school is to be constructed in two phases:-

Phase 1: 1FE pre-school/ teaching provision with supporting spaces (Hall / Studio / Kitchen / Ancillary + Offices) at 2FE required sizes. Phase 1 of the school is due to open in September 2019.

Phase 2: Expansion of school provision to enable full 2FE accommodation. This will be a phased intake generated by the adjacent housing.

All spaces will have potential to accommodate the support technology needed by all learners and staff. The design will also meet the current government guidance for a fully accessible school.
